Being in Christ

When you received Jesus as Lord, God brought you into existence by His Holy Spirit. A seed was sown in your heart – the incorruptible seed of God’s word – which placed you in Christ Jesus.

You need to start to know, understand and experience the reality of knowing Jesus. One of the ways to do this is to read the Bible and underline every place it mentions ‘in Christ’, ‘in Him’ etc. These phrases occur over 130 times. As you come across them in your reading, read them carefully, and study what they mean, and then personalise it e.g. 2 COR 5:17 “If _____ (put your name here) is in Christ, _____ is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!”

To follow are a few examples of what it means to be in Christ. Once you realise these things, you need to walk in the reality of them.

1. **You are saved.**

Read 1 TIM 15&16, HEB 7:25, AC 4:12, ROM 10:13.

ROM 10:9 “We are saved because we have confessed with our _____ and believed in our _____ that God raised Jesus from the dead”.

2. **You are healed.**

Read 1 PT 2:24. MT 8:16&17 IS 53:4&5.

GAL 3:13&14 tells us that Jesus went to the cross; He bore the curse for us, and broke the power of sin, sickness and disease. Our sins were carried by Him and He died in our place. In the same way our diseases were carried by Him so we would not have to. Today Jesus is healed, and lives in perfect health. Because we are in Him, we are healed too!

3. **You are delivered.**

COL 1:13-14 “For He has rescued (delivered) us from the _____ and brought us into the _____ He loves, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins”.

Satan and all his demons have no legal right to harass you. You are living in another kingdom. This means, of course, that we should live like citizens of the new kingdom.

4. You are righteous.

Write out 2 COR 5:21

Righteousness simply means 'being in right standing'. Before you received Jesus as your Lord and Saviour you were not in right standing with God. Now, thanks to what Jesus did, you are standing right before God.

Therefore, you are righteous - not because of anything you have done, but totally due to what He has done! You are to act righteously (not self-righteously). You will find it helpful when thinking about acting righteously to think of righteousness as 'right-choice-ness'. Make choices and decisions that will please God.

5. You are prosperous.

Prosperity is Gods gift to all of us. Prosperity does not necessarily mean you have a great deal of money and possessions. Biblical prosperity is being able to meet a need in any situation, through God. If someone needs healing, you are able to get them their healing from God; if someone needs to be set free from the powers of darkness, you are able to do it; if they have a financial need, you can meet it, etc.

In Closing

To finish this study we will look at the fact that as a child of God, you have been given an inheritance. It is important to study the Bible and find out what your inheritance involves – and then act on that knowledge.
