

Baptism In The Holy Spirit

You will remember from the last study (water baptism) that the ‘one baptism’ in EHP 4:5 was made up of three parts. You have already studied two of these parts and we will now look at being baptised in the Holy Spirit. Water baptism dealt mainly with your past and removing your past life (before salvation). Being baptised in the Holy Spirit deals with your present life and He (the Holy Spirit) will give you power to live your life the way God desires you to.

We all need the Holy Spirit (He is sometimes called the Holy Ghost). He is God on earth with us today. He can be your best friend and He will always point you to Jesus, who will always lead you to the Father (God).

In the book of ACTS, after Jesus had risen from the dead, He talked to His disciples. Jesus said in ACTS 1:5, “... for John truly baptised with water, but you shall be baptised with the Holy Spirit not many days from now”.

1 COR 2: 11-13

“For what man knows the things of a man except the spirit of the man which is in Him? Even so, no one knows the things of God except the Spirit of God. Now, we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God. These things we also speak, not in words which man’s wisdom teaches but which the Holy Spirit teaches, comparing spiritual things with spiritual.

What Is The Baptism In The Holy Spirit?

Baptism means ‘to immerse’.

Purpose Of The Baptism In The Holy Spirit?

1. There are two reasons why you need to receive the Holy Spirit.

ACTS 1:8

“But you will receive _____ when the Holy Spirit comes on you”.

3. The Old Testament tells us that only a few people were given the Holy Spirit. In the New Testament, it is given as a free gift to anyone who will receive it.

EZ 11:19-20 “I will give them an undivided heart and put a new spirit in them; I will remove from them their heart of stone and give them a heart of flesh. Then they will follow my decrees and be careful to keep my laws. They will be my people, and I will be their God”.

This is one of many prophecies in the Old Testament about a time of great outpouring and of signs and wonders. Also read IS 44:3 and JOEL 2:28-32.

4. When you gave your heart and life to Jesus, the Holy Spirit was there. He was the one who re-created your human spirit in the image of God (see study two). When you are filled with His presence He will help you live like God desires you to. He will be your teacher, your guide, and He will enable you to live an abundant life.

How To Receive The Baptism Of The Holy Spirit?

Your salvation was a gift from God; all you had to do was receive it by faith. Because the baptism in the Holy Spirit is also a gift from God, you receive it just the same way – by faith.

You can receive the baptism without any human help. However, it is common to receive it by someone laying their hands on you (this person must have already received the Holy Spirit).

1. You must be born again
2. Ask Jesus to baptise you in the Holy Spirit
3. Receive Him (the Holy Spirit) by faith
4. Open your mouth and begin to speak in tongues. This step is important as it releases our faith. Tongues are an unknown/unlearned language that God instantly gives you when you are baptised. It helps you communicate with God on a higher level in prayer.

MK 16:17 “And these signs will follow those who believe.....they will speak with new tongues”.

1 COR 14:2 “For he who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men, but to God, for no one [no human] understands him; however in the spirit he speaks mysteries”.

[Words in brackets added]

1 COR 14:3 “He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself...”.
