How Vital Is It To Have Faith?

Faith is a solid foundation of the Gospel. It is married to repentance. You can not truly repent without faith in God and it is impossible to have faith in God without repentance – we can not have one without the other.

What Is Faith?

In HEB 11:1 the Bible gives us a definition of what true faith is.

“Now faith is the assurance (the confirmation) of the things we hope for, being the proof of things we do not see and the conviction of their reality – faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses.”

Faith is the noun (naming word). Believe is the verb (doing word).

Where Does Faith Come From?

1. Faith comes when we hear messages through the word of God. The *King James Version* translates ROM 10:17 as follows –

“Faith cometh by hearing and hearing by the word of God”.

2. We are all given an amount of faith by God.

ROM 12:3 “Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of _____ in accordance with the measure of faith God has given you”.

The Bible likens this deposit of faith to a seed in the ground. When a farmer plants a seed it does not grow instantly. Only after it receives light from the sun, water and nutrients it will begin to sprout and grow. Similarly, our seed of faith, when watered by God’s word will begin to grow.

How to Build and Release Your Faith

1. What do you need to do if you want to get faith? _____ ROM 10:1-17

Faith will grow as you read the Bible, studying and meditating on the Scriptures. God can also talk to us. He is often heard as a ‘still small voice’. Faith will also be built in your life as you hear Bible-based preaching in your local church.

2. Heb 11 talks about the great men and women in the Bible who had great faith. They are called our 'heroes of faith'. Faith in the Scriptures is based on a condition of the heart, not the mind. Faith operates in the present and brings change and direction to the future.
